ABOUT ASIAN DOMAIN NAME DISPUTE RESOLUTION CENTRE (ADNDRC)

The Asian Domain Name Dispute Resolution Centre (ADNDRC) provides comprehensive online dispute resolution services for resolving domain name disputes including those arising out of gTLDs, new gTLDs and certain ccTLDs. It is a dispute resolution service provider accredited by the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN). Founded in 2002, today ADNDRC has offices in Beijing (operated by China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission (CIETAC)), Hong Kong (operated by Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre (HKIAC)), Kuala Lumpur (operated by Asian International Arbitration Centre (AIAC)), and Seoul (operated by the Internet address Dispute Resolution Committee (IDRC)).

ADNDRC is governed by its Council composed of leading professionals specialised in domain name dispute resolution, intellectual property, the Internet, and e-commerce. The Council is led by the Chair, and the role of Chair is rotated across the four offices every three years. The work of the Council is supported by the ADNDRC Secretariat, which is currently operated by the Hong Kong office (HKIAC) and overseen by the ADNDRC Secretary-General, Kiran Sanghera.


The current Chair of ADNDRC is Mr. Wang Chengjie. Chengjie steps into the role as Chair with ample experience of managing a dispute resolution centre given his long-standing position as the Vice Chairman & Secretary-General of CIETAC.

In addition to administering domain name dispute resolution proceedings under the UDRP, ADNDRC also administers proceedings under the following ICANN policies:-

Uniform Rapid Suspension System (URS)
Trademark Post-Delegation Dispute Resolution Procedure (TM-PDDRP)
Registrar Transfer Dispute Resolution Policy (TDRP)
Sunrise Dispute Resolution Policy (SDRP)
Charter Eligibility Dispute Resolution Policy (CEDRP)

ADNDRC is also approved by OP3FT to resolve disputes concerning Frogans addresses.

MESSAGE FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

It is with great pleasure that we present the Annual Report of the Asian Domain Name Dispute Resolution Centre (ADNDRC) for 2021.

I am pleased to report on the developments that took place at ADNDRC during the year.

2021 record number of cases

ADNDRC received 272 cases in 2021. This was an increase of 32% from 2020 and a 45% increase from 2019

Secretariat handover

The Hong Kong office of the ADNDRC, operated by the Hong Kong International Arbitration Centre (HKIAC), resumed the role of Secretariat of the ADNDRC in March 2021. HKIAC took the role from the Kuala Lumpur office operated by the Asian International Arbitration Centre (AIAC) who were responsible for the Secretariat from 2018 to 2021.

Appointment of new Chairperson

We welcomed a new Chairperson, Mr. Wang Chengjie, from the Beijing office operated by the China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission (CIETAC). Mr. Wang stepped into the role as the Chair in September 2021 with ample experience of managing a dispute resolution centre given his long-standing position as the Vice Chairman & Secretary-General of CIETAC.

Establishment of Standards and Practice Committee

In 2021, we established the Standards and Practice Committee. The Standards and Practice Committee is the third sub-committee established by ADNDRC. The focus of the Standards and Practice Committee is to (i) to ensure the quality and consistency of case management of ADNDRC; (ii) to discuss and implement standard practices; (iii) to update ADNDRC Supplemental Rules when appropriate; and (iv) to assist in providing feedback on UDRP and UDRP Rules to ICANN. The Standards and Practice Committee supports the work of the ADNDRC together with the existing sub-committees, the Panel Selection Committee and Business Development Committee.

Promotional activities

We launched the ADNDRC Leadership Series. A series of interviews with leading figures in the ADNDRC domain name dispute resolution community. The first interviewees included Dr. Christopher To and Mr. Ho-Hyun Nahm based in Hong Kong and Seoul respectively who I had the pleasure of interviewing. More interviews including from the Beijing and Kuala Lumpur offices will follow in 2022. These interviews provide a unique opportunity to hear from leading figures in domain name dispute resolution in the Asia-Pacific region.

The Seoul office of ADNDRC, operated by the Internet Address Dispute Resolution Committee (IDRC), organised the Annual ADNDRC Conference, the IDRC-ADNDRC International Conference on Domain Name Dispute Resolution, on 29 September 2021.

Plans for 2022

We have a number of important projects for 2022. Those include:

organising the ADNDRC Domain Name Dispute Resolution Practice Development Workshop (Workshop) on 26-27 April. The Workshop is for ADNDRC panellists and those with an interest in joining the ADNDRC Panel. The Workshop aims to provide best practice guidelines, tips on addressing common procedural and legal issues, and the latest case updates.

The Standards and Practice Committee will prepare a set of decision drafting guidelines for UDRP proceedings to provide practical advice to panelists to render effective decisions


The ADNDRC Annual Conference will take place in the second half of 2022 and will be organised by the Beijing office.

We look forward to engaging with the domain name dispute resolution community and continuing to offer efficient, cost-effective and well -administered dispute resolution services to users.




Case Registration




Users' Preference on Number of Panellists


