Since retirement as a judge, mediations have been

conducted at the rate of about 6-8 a year. Arbitrations have also been conducted in respect of patent and commercial matters.

This has also involved work with sports associations, in particular acting as company secretary, Chairman of the disciplinary committee of the Hong Kong Anti-Doping Committee and various charities.
